- * We celebrated World Book Day with pupils making story jars, discovering new books and guessing The Masked Readers.

- * Year 5 were building fires and cooking their own South American stews as part of their Explorer topic and Outdoor Learning.
- * We all took part in Comic Relief today, wearing red, making our class smile and making/eating cakes to raise money.

An overview of the activities coming up in each year group:

Year 3 – Exploring Earth:



- We enjoyed sharing our books on World Book Day last week and we are finishing reading Nim's Island in class.
- Next week, Year 3 Drama Club perform "Geology Rocks", Mrs Robinson's play about what happens when a school digs up an unusual stone while planting seedlings...! We wish them all the best of luck for the show!
- Using Photopea to produce stop-frame animation videos and digitally enhanced artworks for our STEAM project.
- Next term, each class will have the opportunity to take part in our Year 3 swimming lessons to learn and improve their skills. All payments can be made via ParentPay.

Year 4 – Innovations and Inventions:

- Ted Hughes Reading the Iron Man by Ted Hughes, uncovering the secrets to writing a tale of suspense and mystery.
- Developing our understanding of how magnetic fields interact to produce movement.
- Scientific investigation into how magnets can change the direction of a spinning motor.

 - In PE, we are taking part in Athletics and Tennis, beginning to build our sporting skills ready for the summer.

Year 5 – Explorers:

- Developing our teamwork, accuracy and dodging skills in netball.

Year 6 - World War Two:
